Sir,

We duly received your telegrams respecting the yacht "JACINTA", viz:
"JACINTA" forward measurements particulars report form eleven b for free-
board also particulars structural alterations"

and "JACINTA" forward plans structural alterations effected"

and beg to enclose herewith report for hull and machinery and also a free-
board report and plans showing the alterations carried out.

The owners had decided to have a freeboard marked by the Norwegian Verit-
as, but after the vessel had left they decided to have a freeboard marked by
us, so we have had no opportunity to obtain the necessary particulars for
filling out the front side of report 11B.

It will be noted that we recommend the vessel to have a freeboard fitted
as condition of class and the construction of the vessel makes in my opinion
such an arrangement necessary as specially the stern of the vessel is of an
unsatisfactory shape when loaded to the freeboard mark and the stability of
the vessel when the holds are filled with cargo (say coal) ought in my opini-
on be ascertained.

The owners request to know the approximate freeboard which will be as-
signed and I shall be glad if you will kindly wire if the vessel can be
classed 100 A1 and the approximate freeboard.

I shall further communicate with the owners as regards where and when
complete measurements for freeboard can be taken.
