REPORT

By request of Messrs. H. M. Beausire & Co., Lloyd's Agents, Lima, I, the undersigned, repaired to the floating dry dock on the 7th of February, 1918, and surveyed the hull of the Peruvian four masted barque "ELIZABETH" and beg to report the following:

Hull. After being cleaned, I found the shell plating, butts and landings all in good condition.

Rudder. Rudder is hard down on the heel step, and gudgeons bushes are slack.

Recommend ruder to be lifted for examination of pintles.

8th February 1918. Repaired to dock and examined pintles of rudder and them good.

Recommend new heel disc fitted and gudgeons rebushed.

9th February 1918. Repaired to floating dock and found the repairs as recommended duly executed, and the bottom to light water load line coated with anticorrosive and antifouling paints.


In my opinion the vessel is now in a thorough seaworthy condition and fit to load dry and perishable cargo.
