S. Reverting to recent correspondence between us relative to the request which the Committee have received from the Peruvian Government for reclassification surveys to be held at Callao on the steamer "LA CONSTITUCION" and the sailing vessel "ELISABETH", I beg to acquaint you that I have now heard definitely from the Peruvian Legation in the matter.

I have also received a request from the Owner of a third vessel, the barque "ALLIANCE", for a survey to be held on this vessel at Callao with a view to reclassification, and it is thought that it may be possible for a survey to be held as desired while the surveys of the other two vessels are in progress.

From a letter dated 17th March which has just been received from Mr. Smith, it appears that he has recently proceeded to Panama on instructions from your goodselfs, and that his address is c/o your Office at Panama. In the circumstances, I enclose herewith a cablegram addressed to Mr. Smith at Panama with the necessary instructions as regards the surveys referred to above, and I shall be much obliged

if you will kindly cause this message to be forwarded
and debit me with the cost.
