Dear Sir,

With further reference to the case of the sailing vessel "Osborne" and to my letter of the 18th inst., I beg to inform you that the Superintendent this morning requested me to examine the vessel in the 'tween decks, which are now clear; this I declined to do, putting it off until the whole of the vessel is ready for inspection. I however arranged with him that if possible the vessel shall be dry-docked without ballast

ballast on board, so that the inside & outside of the vessel can be fully examined at the same time. It will therefore be unnecessary to hold a survey on the floors Cement &c before she goes into Dock.
