Dear Sir,

The Four Masted Ship "Osborne"
of Liverpool, owned by Messrs Macvicar,
Marshall & Co., arrived here this afternoon.

The discharge of the cargo commenced
at once; it is expected that she
will be clear in about a fortnight:
the cargo will probably be removed
from the Main hold in about
11 or 12 days, when an opportunity
will occur for lifting ceiling at
the middle of the vessel for
examination of floor, Cement &c.,
before

before ballast is put in to
keep the vessel stable, while
Cargo is removed from the
ends. The 'tween decks may
be ready for examination
at the beginning of next
week. The Vessel will be
Dry Docked as soon as
the cargo has been discharged.

I shall at once inform you
if any material alteration
is made in the above
arrangements.
