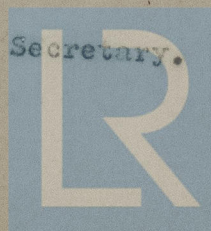
I shall, therefore, be glad if you will kindly let me know when and at what port the vessel will arrive.
