Nature of Survey

Damage

This is a preliminary report from which it appears the vessel has arrived at Calcutta having encountered bad weather and she is now under survey.

A large number of frame joints are reported to be slack and many bolts leaking.

As the vessel is now under survey, it is submitted action in this case should be deferred till the repairs are completed. The Surveyor should be requested to report fully the details of the damage found, and the repairs found necessary, when his survey is completed.
