With reference to your intimation that the repairs of damage to the steamer "WAVERLEY" are completed except the testing of the water ballast tanks in the engine room, I have to request that you will be good enough to make out and forward a report of your survey on a repair report form immediately the survey is completed.

At the same time I think it well to intimate that in all future cases of a like nature where the surveys are only partially held before the vessel leaves your port as in the present instance, it is desirable that you should forward without delay your reports of survey/so far as complete and not detain them until the vessel's return.
