With reference to your letter of the 3rd instant respecting the Motor Barque "ELFLEDA", I have to inform you that in this case having regard to the size and position of the auxiliary motors placed in this sailing vessel it is not considered necessary that a bulkhead or recess should be fitted in the position stated in your letter.

At the same time I have to state that it may be noted that the bulkhead at the forward end of the machinery space has been efficiently constructed and stiffened as a watertight bulkhead.
