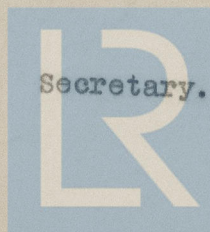
With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the barque "ELFLEDA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them reports from the Society's Surveyors at Christiania to the effect that the 2nd Special Survey No.3 has now been carried out, and that the vessel has been fitted with twin auxiliary motors.

It appears however that in fitting the propeller brackets new pieces have been welded on the bosses by the electric welding process, and I have to say that in view of the adoption of this method of dealing with the brackets, it is considered that they should be specially examined each time the vessel is placed in dry dock; and her class has accordingly been continued by the Committee subject to this condition being fulfilled.

I have the pleasure to enclose herewith certificates of classification in connexion with the recent survey.
