The 2nd Special Survey No.3 which became due in June, 1913, has now been held.

The plating has been drilled with the results as shown above which may be considered as satisfactory.

The vessel has been placed in dry dock and the following repairs effected due to wear and tear, viz:— the rudder plates partly renewed, 4 shell plates renewed, a number of deck planks renewed and minor repairs effected to the spars, &c.

Two Bolinder motors have been fitted aft and a watertight bulkhead has been fitted at fore end of engine room.

The bulkhead engine seatings, boss plates, &c. have been constructed in accordance with the ^{approved} plans attached.
