
Sir,

I beg to inform you that the owner of the sailing vessels "FINGAL" No. 87 in the Register Book and "ELFLEDA" No. 124 in the Register Book intend to fit two motors in each vessel as auxiliary engines. The motors are intended to be fitted aft. I shall be glad to know what arrangements there will be required as regards the bulkheads especially the height and the strength of the bulkheads and whether a watertight recess, through which the two stern tubes will be fitted, can be approved.

It appears to me that the vessels are calculated to make a speed of 6 knots with the engines proposed and I shall be glad if you will also let me know if any extra stiffening of the vessel will be required except engine bearers etc.
