On the 12th June, 1913, the Owner stated this vessel was then on a voyage from Fredrikstad to Zanzibar, and asked that he might be allowed the year of grace within which to carry out the above survey. In the circumstances the Committee deferred action in the case for a time.

On the 20th December the Owner stated the vessel was loading in British East Africa for the United Kingdom or Continent and that on the discharge of her cargo, which he expected would be in May, the necessary inspection would take place, and the Committee agreed to this arrangement.

On the 8th ultimo the Owner stated he would shortly

to Havre, where the vessel had recently arrived, in order to make arrangements for the survey to be held.

In a letter dated 6th instant the Havre Surveyors wrote they had been informed by the Broker that the vessel was discharged and would proceed to Tonsberg on the 7th instant, where the survey would be carried out. They added that nothing had been done in Havre to advance the survey.
