On the 12th June last the Owner stated this vessel was then on a voyage from Fredrikstad to Zanzibar, and asked that he might be allowed the year of grace within which to carry out the above survey. In reply he was informed that in view of the vessel's destination the Committee had deferred action in the case.

On the 20th December the Owner stated the vessel was loading in British East Africa for the United Kingdom or Continent and that on the discharge of her cargo, which he expected would be in May, the necessary inspection would take place, and the Committee agreed to this arrangement.
