Referring to my report no. 1348, respecting a 120 B.H.P. Bolinder Motor, built for Tryggve Styri, Esq., of Christiania, the local representative to the Bolinder Co., I hereby respectfully beg to intimate to You, that I have been informed by the Society's Surveyor at Christiania, Mr. C.A. Lystad, that this motor, together with another Bolinder motor of the same type and size, not yet tested and reported on, is to be fitted in the steel Bk. "ELFLEDA" (no. 124 in R.B.), of Horten, Norway, which vessel is classed in our Society.

The fitting of these motors is to be carried out by the Framnaes Mek. Verksted, of Sandefjord, Norway, under special survey.
