Sir,  
I duly received your letter of the 1st instant respecting the sailing vessels "FINGAL" and "ELFLEDA" and beg to inform you that I have to-day forwarded by Commercial Papers Post for approbation plan in duplicate of watertight bulk head etc. at fore part of motorroom for the Bk. "ELFLEDA". The proposed scantlings of bulkhead appears to be as required by the Rules except the vertical stiffeners in way of lower hold which are to be 6" x 3" x .40" bulb as the depth appears to be 12'-3".

As the builders are in a hurry to have the repairs started I shall be glad if you will kindly wire wether the proposed scantlings will be approved.

Particulars of the motors shall be forwarded as soon as possible.
