
respecting the proposal of Messrs. "ITALIA" to instal two second-hand Cochran Boilers Nos.16778/9 in Motor Vessels of the "FELLA" class.

We also thank you for your letters "E" of 8th and 9th instant, and have to state that the copies of the plans of the Boilers in question have now come safely to hand.

Boiler N°16779 has now been tested under hydraulic pressure and found sound and tight at 200 lb/sq.".

It was immediately despatched to Trieste and it is stated will be installed on the M/V "FELLA". We are expecting to test the second boiler in a few days' time, and if found satisfactory this will also be despatched to Trieste for the purpose of installing on board the M/V "CELLINA".
