I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant, respecting the proposal to instal two second-hand Cochran Boilers Nos.16778/9 in Motor Vessels of the "FELLA" class, and I note that these boilers have been examined and found in good condition.

In confirmation of ^{my} telegram to you to-day, as below, I have to inform you that, provided the boilers be found tight and sound when tested by hydraulic pressure, these boilers will be accepted for a working pressure of 100 lb. per square inch.

Further, the details of the safety valves, as stated in your letter, are in order, but the valves should be adjusted and an accumulation test carried out when the boilers are under steam.

I have to point out that while the material of these boilers was made and tested in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, and the scantlings were examined and found to meet the Rules for the intended working pressure, the boilers were not constructed under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors.
