Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 23rd ultimo forwarding (in duplicate) a revised plan of Simplex Balance rudders to be fitted on the Motorships "FELLA", "FELTRE", "CELLINA" & "RIALTO", which are stated to be under reconstruction at present at the Yard of Messrs. Cantieri Riuniti dell'Adriatico, Trieste.

The plan is returned herewith, and I have to state that the arrangements and scantlings as shewn and amended thereon will be approved, provided they be carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, and provided the consent of the Owners be obtained to cutting away the corner of the palm forming the scarp on the rudder body casting as proposed.

Special care should be taken with the fitting and welding of the filling in piece and to ensure that the joint of the scarp is properly closed.

The duplicate copy of the plan is being retained.
