I duly received your letter of the 31st ultimo, with enclosures advised therein, respecting the crank shafts proposed for the new Auxiliary Engines intended to be constructed by Messrs. FIAT (S.G.M.), Turin, for the above motorships, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that with 4SCSA engines for driving auxiliary machinery, having 5 cylinders, 175 mm. diameter by 300 mm. stroke, span of bearings 204 mm., maximum pressure in cylinders 50 kg/cm^2 , M.I.P. 5 kg/cm^2 , B.H.P. 100, revs. per min. 600, the following size of crank shaft will be approved, viz:- 110 mm. diameter

The plan showing details of crank shaft will also be approved.
