Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "PARTHENON", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had under their consideration a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Constantinople from which it appears that the Captain, on the occasion of his being on his way down to the Mediterranean recently, informed them that the vessel would be stopped on the way up in ballast in order that the second Special Survey No.3 might be carried out.

Under the circumstances and in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the Completion of the survey expired at the end of last month, the Committee direct me to say that unless the survey be carried out at Constantinople as now arranged they will be obliged to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Society's Register Book.
