In November last the Owners stated that they had given instructions to the Master to have the survey held at Marseilles or Constantinople.

The Surveyor at Constantinople stated last month that the vessel had been lying up for a long period at Seio where she had been scaled, cleaned etc. She was expected to arrive at his port in a few days in ballast when he would endeavour to obtain some information from the Master in regard to the matter.

The Surveyor now states that the vessel recently arrived in ballast and that he had found much done in the way of scraping,
