Herewith I enclose the weekly return of vessels under survey for the week ending this day.

In respect to the S.S. "Parkman" which arrived here in ballast at the end of last week after the Return had been posted, a preliminary examination has been made. I found that much had been done in the way of scraping, chipping and painting; but as she was leaving under charter the same day, it was impossible to do more than look round.

The Captain who is part owner, assures me that it is the intention to carry out the survey at this Port, and that he will arrange to remain here on the arrival of the vessel in ballast next voyage.
