Dear Sir,

S. I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant respecting the case of your Bk. "EAST GROFT", and having submitted the same to the Committee I am directed to say that as it is not your intention to carry out the Special Survey No. 2 at St. Nazaire, or to send the vessel direct to Genoa in ballast, the Committee regret they have no alternative but to expunge her class from the Society's Register Book with a Red Line indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have at the same time to add that immediately upon the vessel being submitted for the Special Survey No. 2 and all necessary repairs, and upon receipt of a satisfactory report thereon from the Society's Surveyors, the vessel will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for the re-instatement of her character.
