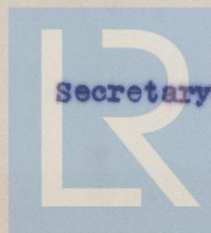
I duly received your post-card of the 27th ultimo relative to your Bk. "EAST CROFT", and note your remarks.
