The 3rd.S.S.No. 2 became due in August 1908.

Action was deferred in January 1909, as the Copenhagen Surveyors recommended that a number of indented plates should be either renewed or faired on the vessel's return from her contemplated voyage to Australia.

The case was before the Committee on the 14th September last, when in view of the vessel being laid up at St.Nazaire, the late Owner furnished the usual undertaking.

This vessel has been recently purchased by Mr. Adolfo Magnano, of Genoa, and on the 25th ultimo the case was again before the Committee, when the Owner was informed that unless the vessel proceeded direct from St.Nazaire to Genoa in ballast, and was submitted for Special Survey immediately on her arrival, the Committee would have no option but to expunge the vessel's class forthwith, and he was requested to state, in course of post, what arrangements he proposed making in the matter.

No reply has yet been received from the Owner, and the Nantes Surveyor now states that he has not received any news in regard to this vessel, or to her contemplated voyage.

It is submitted action in the meantime might be deferred, and the Nantes Surveyor requested to inform this Office immediately in the event of the vessel leaving his port.
