Dear Sir,

S I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th instant respecting the Bk. "EAST CROFT", and to acquaint you that the case of this vessel was again considered by the Committee at their meeting today.

In reply I am directed to say that as the Third Special Survey No.2 of the vessel is so very long overdue, the Committee regret they cannot agree to her making a voyage with cargo as you propose, and that unless the vessel proceeds direct to Genoa in ballast and is there submitted for the Special Survey immediately upon her arrival, they will have no option but to expunge the class forthwith.

I shall therefore be glad to learn in course of post what arrangements you propose making in the matter.
