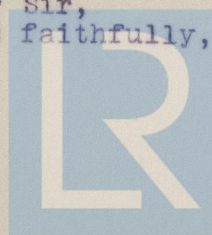

I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Genoa have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 11th instant respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Bk. "EAST CROFT", now your property, and that the case has received the careful consideration of the Committee. As you are no doubt aware the 3rd Special Survey No.2 prescribed by the Rules is considerably overdue on the vessel and a number of indented plates require to receive attention, and the vessel's class has been allowed by the Committee to remain undisturbed upon a definite understanding that these matters would be attended to before she again proceeded to sea. In the circumstances you name, however, I have to say that the Committee will be agreeable to fall in with your wishes subject to the vessel proceeding direct from St. Nazaire to Genoa in ballast and being immediately submitted for the Special Survey in question upon her arrival at Genoa.
