Your favour of the 2nd February to Mr. Isaksson of Stockholm has been handed over to me for answering. I regret to note, that the Third Periodical Survey is now due. I regret this the more, as I have been misled as to this, when buying the vessel, as I was then informed, that she would not be due for Survey before October 1916. As she is fixed in timecharter until the end of this year, during which time it will be impossible for me to carry out the survey, I therefore herewith venture to ask you, that the survey may be postponed until the beginning of January 1915. I beg to enclose some certificates proving, that I have spent a considerable amount in order to keep the steamer in a good condition and as she is now, and will be very well kept up, I hope you will kindly consent.-
