

S.S. "AGNES".

This vessel was built in 1877 and was originally classed with the Underwriters Registry. The Owners now desire to have the machinery classed.

The main boiler was renewed in 1891, and the donkey boiler in 1903. The Copenhagen Surveyor states that the engines and boilers have been thoroughly overhauled and repaired, and are now in good condition, and he forwards a report giving particulars of the engines and plans of the main and donkey boilers.

The shafting is in accordance with the Rules which were in force in 1891 when the new boiler was fitted and the boilers are in accordance with the Rules for a working pressure of 80 lbs per square inch.

It is submitted that the record of LMC 8.14 might be assigned with notations NB.91. and NDB.03. *when fees have been paid.*
