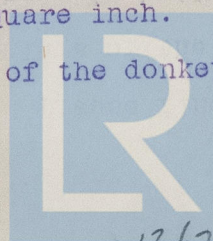
Dear Sir,

Enclosed please find for the Committee's consideration particulars of the engines of the s.s. "Agnes" and a plan of the main boiler as requested in your letter of the 27th ultimo.

The engines and boilers have been thoroughly overhauled and repaired under our inspection and are now in good condition, the main boiler has been tested by hydraulic pressure to 120 lbs. per square inch after completion of repairs and found tight and good.

The owners have requested us to apply to the Committee for the same working pressure carried at present, viz:- 80 lbs. per square inch.
