Dear Sir,

S. With reference to the Third Periodical Survey of the steamer "AGNES", I beg to point out that the period within which this inspection is required to be held expired in December last.

It appears, however, from a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Copenhagen that the vessel is laid up at Elsinore, and I have to say that, in the meantime, the Committee will be agreeable to her class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present, subject to the conditions usually required in similar cases, viz:- that the survey be completed before the vessel is again sent to sea, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and should she be offered for sale to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain subject to this being done, and to advise this Office of the name and address of the purchasers as soon as a sale is effected.

I shall therefore be glad to learn that you are willing to agree to these conditions.
