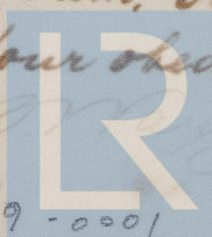
I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th inst regarding the case of the barque "Latona" in which you state that provided you do not sell the vessel as she stands you will do the whole of the repairs suggested as necessary by Mr. Dawes, and, in reply, I am directed to intimate that, with reference to the retention of the vessels classification in the Register Book, the Committee require it to be clearly understood that in the event of your disposing of the vessel, as you suggest, intending purchasers must be fully apprised ^{by you} of the repairs which the Society's Surveyors consider to be required in this case, as set forth by Mr. Dawes.
