

Extract of letter from Mr. J.B. Conway. Overlooker
on behalf of owners, and underwriters on ship Latona

Dunedin 14th July 1884

The Surveyor is Captain Russell who was called by the Master & Agents to Survey the ship when she first arrived & also in dry Dock & on whose report (a copy of which I sent you) the repairs of the vessel had been determined upon & carried out. He expressed himself quite satisfied with the repairs prior to her loading, as everything was done to make the vessel in first class order & to retain her character of A1 at Lloyds. I believe he had made her Certificate out, but when he found she was making water he would not give it & sent us a letter to that effect 12 days after the repairs were finished & 10 days after the vessel was loaded ready for sea, a copy of which I will enclose.

We had reason to believe the Surveyor (Captain Russell) was influenced by the underwriters of the cargo, as he is in the service of the underwriters association here & we called another survey (independant) which has turned out in our favour, a copy of which I enclose, as she has been proved to be making only 5/8 in per hour & slowly taking up.

The Underwriters have done all they could to separate the cargo from the vessel, I suppose having repented taking the risk, but I dont think after this last survey, they can offer any further objection, but there is no doubt Captain Russell will do all in his power to throw obstacles in the way, as he has been completely thrown over. He showed his petty spite to-day, by going on board the ship & telling the mate he would condemn the Chain Cables, but we have provided for that in last independent survey, Captain Thomson being a most eligible, having been Harbour Master for many years & now Dock Master of this port, his opinion is far before that of Captain Russell, especially as Captain Russell is interested he is not. David Law signed

associated with him (Captain Thomson) is a very respectable master shipwright whose opinion is of weight as it is well known no man could tamper with him.
