

Extract from letters from Mr Conway, overseer on behalf  
of owners & underwriters on ship Latona

Dunedin 7 August 1884

"We have had a communication from Grain Agency Co  
(Shippers of cargo) the first on Monday last, informing us that the  
Insurance Company had withdrawn their objection, and  
that they had accepted the latter surveys of the vessel—  
Seaworthiness; that under these circumstances they were  
prepared to pay over the £1000 you had sent out, on condition  
that a Bottomry Bond be given for remainder of disbursements."

Dunedin 15 August 1884

"I am glad to inform you the vessel is only making  
very little water now - She only takes 5 minutes to pump  
out after standing 14 hours - She will proceed to sea on  
Monday the 18th inst. if no hitch occurs"
