Dunedin 20 June 1884

We have received your cablegram of 24th May —
In accordance with your instructions therein we at once
— authorized for tenders for the execution of the necessary
repairs to your barge Latern in order that she might resume
her voyage with as little expense & loss of time as possible
The repairs have been of an extensive nature, the vessel
having had to be re-sheathed. The amount of the tender
accepted was £539, with an additional amount for her mail,
£60.00 at schedule prices.

Mr. Conway is superintending the repairs, as you
desired by wire.

We are now pleased to be able to report that the work is
nearly completed & she will soon be in a position to
re-ship her cargo and proceed on her voyage.
