

Extract from Mr. Dalgety's letter dated Dumedin  
20<sup>th</sup> August 1888.

Dumedin 20<sup>th</sup> August 1888

With regard to Captain Russell's report as Surveyor for Lloyd's Register which is dated 10<sup>th</sup> July we wish to point out that although this is dated 10<sup>th</sup> July, the dates on which his Board her Survey were obtained were before 6<sup>th</sup> July, the same which day he had no men on board the steamer. We had repeatedly requested him to send us a report after the vessel had taken in her cargo after coming out of dock, & as he neglected to do this, we, as already advised you, have the vessel surveyed by Captain Thomson late Harbour Master & M.R. Law & subsequently by the present Harbour Master Captain Macfarlane & T. R. Fletcher. These Surveys are held to be quite as trustworthy & reliable as any by Captain Russell & they have been accepted by the Underwriters of the cargo - by the Grays Agency Co. the shippers of the cargo & also by the Standard Insurance Co. who have insured the vessel for the holder of the Bottomry Bond.  
W<sup>m</sup> Conway who was appointed by you to superintend the necessary repairs on behalf of the Owners & Underwriters has been most attentive & careful.
