Built under special survey at Port Dinorwic in November, 1866. Originally classed 13 years A1 at Lloyd's, and continued for 9 A1 from 1877, but, in order to maintain this class, she has to undergo certain repairs required by Lloyd's. Is copper fastened, and was sheathed with yellow metal in June last, when she had a large number of new treenails, new kneebolts, &c., &c.; carries 410 to 420 tons dead weight, and requires no ballast. Has delivered her last cargo (grain from New Zealand) in first-class order. Dimensions:—Length, 115 feet; breadth, 25 feet; depth, 14.8 feet.
