
As requested in your letter of April 28th we beg herewith send for consideration a First Entry Report giving the scantlings etc. of the Steamer " **ARMONIA** " which is at present undergoing a Second Special Survey N° 3 at this Port, with a view to Classification in Lloyd's Register. -

The vessel has been carefully examined, & found to be in good condition, ~~by us~~, and the material of which she is constructed shows practically no decay except at the tank top plating below the Boilers, bulkheads & c in bunkers, the wood upper deck is worn in places & other small local decay & these are being dealt with. -

The shell plating has not yet been drilled below the water line, & the double bottom tanks have not been tested. -

The equipment of anchors, chain cables & ropes, the hatchway beams, fore & afters & covers are to be made in accordance with the rules & the thickness of the mast plating is to be ascertained. -

We shall be glad to know if the stiffening of the collision bulkhead, as given in the report, is considered to be satisfactory. -
