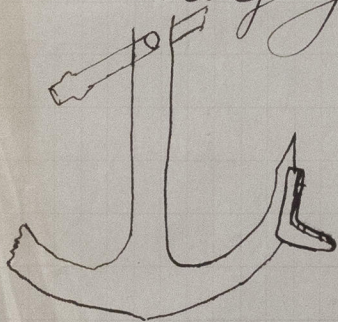
Sir

1. In ^{ANSW} reply to your classing letter of the 2nd August referring to the S.S. Etna. I beg to state that this anchor is a secondhand bower anchor as the sketch below & that this anchor not being new I have not tried it in relation to the weight & I thought that it was sufficient that the test should be that required by the rules; and 37½ tons is much more than the test required for an anchor of this type & for such a vessel as the S.S. Etna.

2. Concerning the S.S. Alice I beg to inform you that I am still waiting for the certificate, to be cancelled, the left half of certificate not being yet returned to me.
