With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer ~~ETNA~~ I beg to remind you that in August last this vessel was supplied with an anchor to replace one lost, but that upon examination of it by the Society's Surveyors at Genoa, no test marks were found and it was understood to be intended to have the anchor tested and the certificate of test submitted for inspection by the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff, for which port the vessel was sailing.

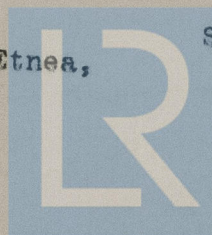
