When due

It is submitted the Owners should be informed that the Genoa Surveyors reported in August last that an anchor had been supplied to this vessel, but no test marks were found on the same — and that the Captain stated that this anchor would be tested on the vessel's arrival at Cardiff. As the vessel has not yet arrived at Cardiff, the Owners should be asked to state when and at what port the above matter will be attended to, in order that the vessel may be eligible to retain the figure 1 for equipment.
