This case was before the Committee in April last when the vessel was allowed to remain as classed and to have record of survey 4,00 Cff. when the spare bower anchor had been replaced.

The Genoa Surveyors now report that a large anchor has been placed on board, upon examination however no marks have been found on it.

The Captain proposes to have this anchor tested and certificates <sup>at Cardiff</sup> procured for same <sup>is sailing</sup> for which port the vessel ~~has now sailed~~.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed subject to the anchor being tested and found satisfactory.
