Sir,

I beg to forward the enclosed letter received from the Captain of the Iron *La Salathie* No. 37 in Reg. bk. The vessel arrived here about 20 days ago, & soon after her arrival we called on board & drew the Captain's attention to the vessel being due for S.S. No. 3. He stated that she had been recently dry-docked at La Pallie, but had not been seen by the Society's Surveyor, & that he had no intention of doing anything towards the Survey at this time. Upon the receipt of the enclosed letter, I visited the vessel, and find that she has now 450 tons of her outward cargo on board, which she is loading for Iquique, under these circumstances I have informed the Captain it is not now practicable to proceed with the Survey.

at this time, & it is understood that
 the *Surrey* will be held in nine months
 time, on return from present voyage,
 when the vessel will be again placed in
 dry dock, probably at this port.
