


Translation of a letter addressed by A.C. Le Quellec, Bordeaux, to the Society's Surveyor at that port, dated 21st. July, 1896.

I return herewith the letter which you received from the Secretary of Lloyd's Register, London, together with that from Lloyd's Agent at Algiers relating to the steam steering gear barrel of my s.s. "DIONE". We have noted the remark of Lloyd's Agent at Algiers and what is necessary will be done.

I have likewise received a letter which the Secretary of Lloyd's Register, London, wrote to me respecting my ship "GALATHEE". I am to-day writing to London on this subject to tell him that the Captain wrote to me on the 28th. June last that M. Plisson, Lloyd's Agent, had passed the survey. The "GALATHEE" is now at West Hartlepool.
