Sir,

In reply to your favour of the 18th
 instant in further reference to the case of the
 barque "Galathée", my report No. 520,
 I beg to inform you that the strakes indicated
 on sketch are those which have actually
 been drilled.

As regards the thicknesses ascertained by
 drilling, I should state that holes were
 drilled at the thinnest points in strakes and
 that the diminution found in such places
 did not appear being widespread, but only
 local, and the general condition of plating
 is in my opinion satisfactory.
