H. Gentlemen,

Reverting to your letter of the 16th December last relative to the bk. "DECAPOLIS", I shall be glad to learn whether this vessel is still lying up at Genoa.

At the same time I think it well to inform you that in reply to my letter of the 20th December, a copy of which was forwarded to you, the Owner wrote that should the vessel not be sold he would complete the Third Special Survey No3 before the vessel proceeded to sea. A further letter was therefore written to him on the 28th December asking him to undertake to inform intending purchasers of this condition of the vessel's class, but no reply has yet been received.

I shall therefore be glad if you will endeavour to obtain from the Owner and forward to me a written undertaking to this effect.
