I have to acquaint you that to complete the Third Special Survey No. 3 of the bk. "DECAPOLIS", recently partly held at Genoa, the whole of the close ceiling and all oxidation requires to be removed, the hold, peaks and plating in way of the side lights to be examined, the sea cock in the peak and the hatches to be examined, the bowsprit wedges to be removed and the shell plating to be drilled.

The vessel is now on her way to Buenos Aires where it is understood the inspection in question will be completed and I shall therefore be glad for the case to receive the necessary attention in due course.

An extract from the First Entry report, together with instructions, are enclosed for your information and guidance in dealing with the case.
