ANSWER.

This vessel, which was sunk in the Whangpoo River, is reported to have been refloated and taken away by the Japanese in October 1938.

I shall be glad if you will endeavour to ascertain whether she is again in commission under the Japanese flag (and, if so, under what name and Ownership she is sailing) or whether she is lying up or has been broken up.
