THE SITUATION IN CHINA
London, Nov. 7.—In reply to inquiry with reference to the vessels sunk to form a boom in the River Whangpoo off Nantao, Lloyd's Agents at Shanghai write under date of Oct. 11: Although exact information is not available it is almost safe to report that the following vessels were scuttled:
